Mekedatu only solution for B'luru water crisis: DKS

Min says 20% people living in city depend on private water tankers

DEPUTY Chief Minister DK Shivakumar on Tuesday said that an estimated 20% of people living in Bengaluru depend on private tanker operators for drinking water.

"About 20% of Bengaluru is getting water from these tanker operators. The solution for this problem is the proposed Mekedatu reservoir project. We are making all efforts to make it possible and I need your (Opposition) cooperation too," he said in the Assembly.

Shivakumar was replying to Jayanagar MLA CK Ramamurthy, who raised the issue of drinking water not being supplied to flats constructed by the Karnataka Slum Development Board.

The DyCM pointed out that the city's population increased by 10 lakh every year and it has become difficult for the authorities to supply drinking water to all.

"We need 6.5 tmcft more Cauvery water to meet the demand in Bengaluru. It is our responsibility to provide drinking water to all," he said.

Deputy Leader of Opposition Arvind Bellad said, "While Shivakumar says there is water shortage, how come private tanker operators are supplying

K'ATA DEPUTY CM BOOKED IN DA CASE

Bengaluru: In a surprising development, the Karnataka Lokayukta police have registered an FIR against Deputy Chief Minister DK Shivakumar to probe the ₹74.93-crore disproportionate assets case against him under the Prevention of Corruption Act. The FIR was filed 50 days after the case was transferred by the state government to Lokayukta police for probe. The Congress government issued a notification on December 2023, transferring the case to Lokayukta. This was after issuing a notification on November 2023, withdrawing consent granted to CBI for investigation in 2019, by BJP government.

Shivakumar said the water tariff in the city has not been revised in the past 11 years. "Although other utilities, including Bescom, have revised tariffs several times since 2013, the BWSSB hasn't. This is due to various reasons, including political," he added.

Replies to Bellad, Shivakumar said the private tanker operators have their own borewells.

COIMBATORE District (Rural) police on Tuesday evening refuted claims made by actor and director K Bhagyaraj that several incidents of drowning that happened along the Bhavani river in Mettupalayam were not accidents but murders committed by people with expertise in diving in order to make money by retrieving the bodies.

On Tuesday morning, Bhag-

yaraj shared a video post on X (formerly Twitter) under the title 'Nenju Porukkuthillaye' detailing the alleged tragedies that had happened in Bhavani River near the Bathrakaaliamman Temple in Mettupalayam. Following this, several people posted videos stating the actor's claims are true.

In the evening police refuted it on the official page of the TN Fact Check unit. Police de-

clared the claims as rumour and clarified that no such incident had been reported in Mettupalayam police limit till date.

As per sources, in 2022, a total of 20 people drowned in the river. Considering the loss of lives, a special unit namely 'Mettupalayam Life Guards' trained by NDRC and SDRF was formed in 2023 and they continue their patrol across the river banks to

ensure incidents of drowning are averted. As a result, the number of deaths came down to six in 2023 and no death has been reported so far in 2024. In all the reported cases in 2022 and 2023, investigation has been conducted and negligence or overconfidence has been ascertained as the reason for the deaths, said the police. Further, 13 people who jumped into the river in a bid to end their lives were rescued and given counselling by the special team.

Prathish's father B Srikanth is an engineering assistant in All India Radio, Thoothukudi, and his mother M Ram Chitra is a former employee of India Post. School Education Minister Anbal Mahesh in his X handle congratulated Prathish on his performance. "Prathish has brought pride to Tamil Nadu. Heartiest congratulations to him for being among the top 23 students in the All India Rank list, and to school teachers and parents who supported him," he said.

The second session of the JEE (Mains) examination will be conducted in April after which a combined rank list of the students from session I and

II will be released. Students who are not happy with their performance in the first session can reappear for the exam in April apart from those who are applying fresh. "As far as we have seen, students from the state have performed well, scoring about 90 percentile. We expect the cut off for the general category to be around 90 percentile and these students will be qualified to write JEE (Advanced). We expect the Tamil Nadu students to do better than last year and we will know the number of students qualifying after session II results," said B Pavan Kumar, deputy director of FIITJEE, Chennai. The second session of the JEE (Mains) will be conducted from April 4 to 15.

DRDO, AIIMS join hands to boost military physiology

BHUBANESWAR: The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) is set to collaborate with all 18 AIIMS in the country to prepare a unique database of the Indian population in terms of their susceptibility to different environmental conditions. The database will be helpful in developing optimum deployment strategies and also designing climate-compatible defence equipment for the Armed forces. Initial discussions with AIIMS, Bhubaneswar, is already over. The institute will collaborate with DRDO for research on heat stress susceptibility factors, which play a significant role in the entire troop deployment cycle in adverse weather conditions. "DRDO and all AIIMS will be working together for a project called Viswakarma. We will research human-machine interface related aspects to create a database on the population. With the data, we will use AI and machine learning technology to develop the Viswakarma platform," a senior scientist told TNIE. ENS
